

Christine Harms is currently the Coordinator for the California Fire Foundation, a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization providing emotional and financial assistance to families of fallen firefighters, firefighters and the communities they protect. Formed in 1987 by California Professional Firefighters, the California Fire Foundation's mandate includes an array of victim and survivor assistance projects and community initiatives.
