Michael put himself through Bakersfield College and subsequently studied Justice Administration at the University of New Haven in Connecticut, graduating with honors in Criminology.

He worked for the United States Department of Justice, then returned to Kern County with a job as an advocate for youth and led an agency that provided health insurance to underprivileged children, and served as a Kern County Supervisor.

Michael was elected to the State Senate in 2010, and had the distinction of being the state's youngest senator. He was awarded the John F. Kennedy Jr. Leadership Award from the California Democratic Party.
