In the legislature, Henry served in the state Assembly representing California's 31st district from 2010-2015. During his tenure, he served as Chairman to three separate policy committees including Revenue and Taxation, Insurance and Agriculture. Other standing committees he served on include Government Organization, Banking and Finance, and Elections and Redistricting.
