

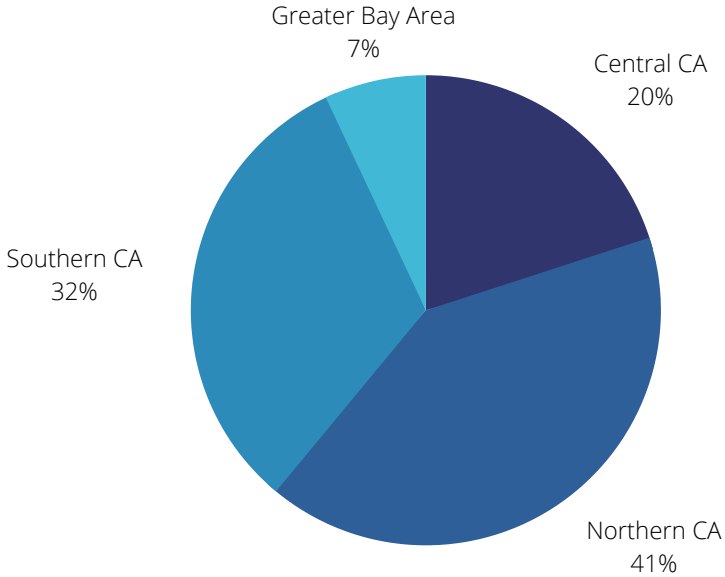

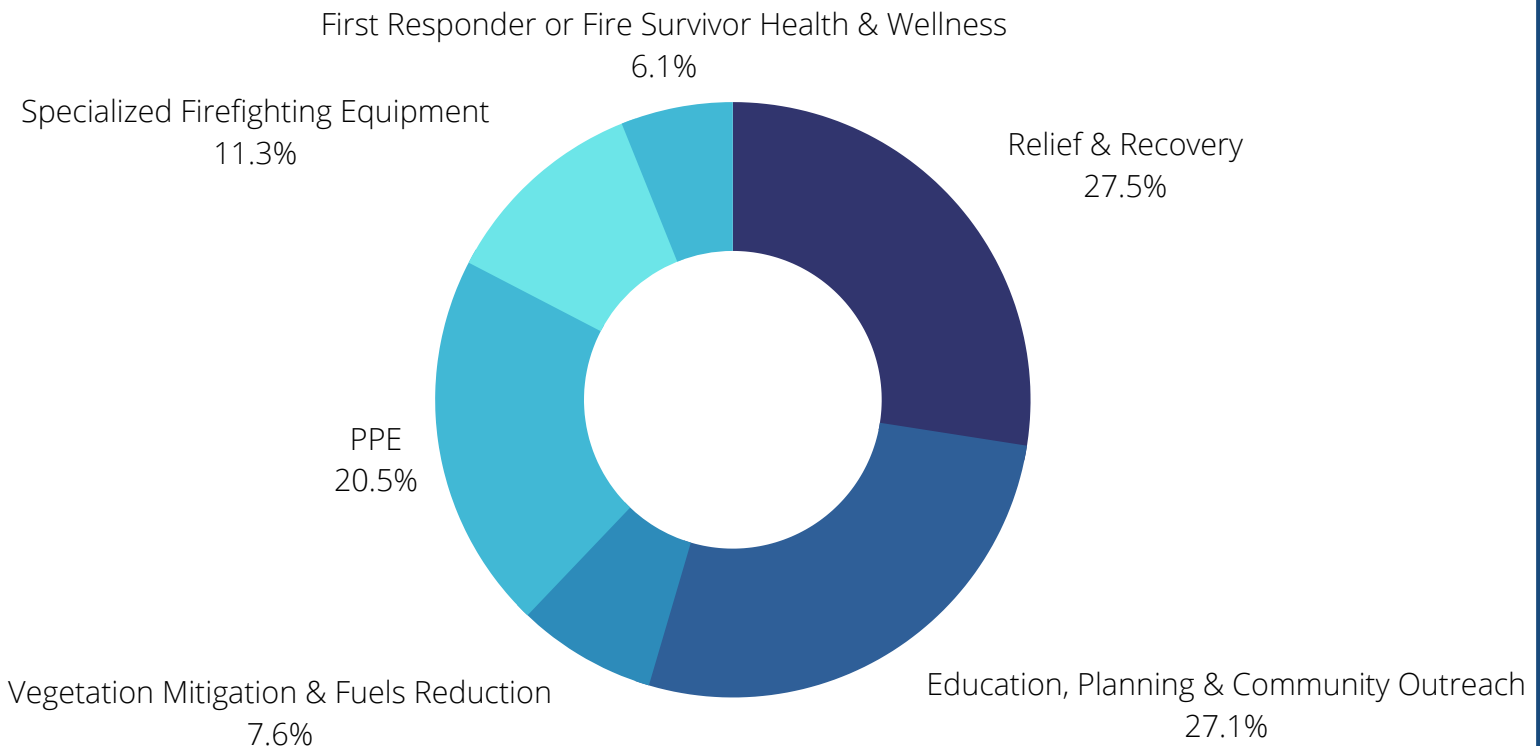

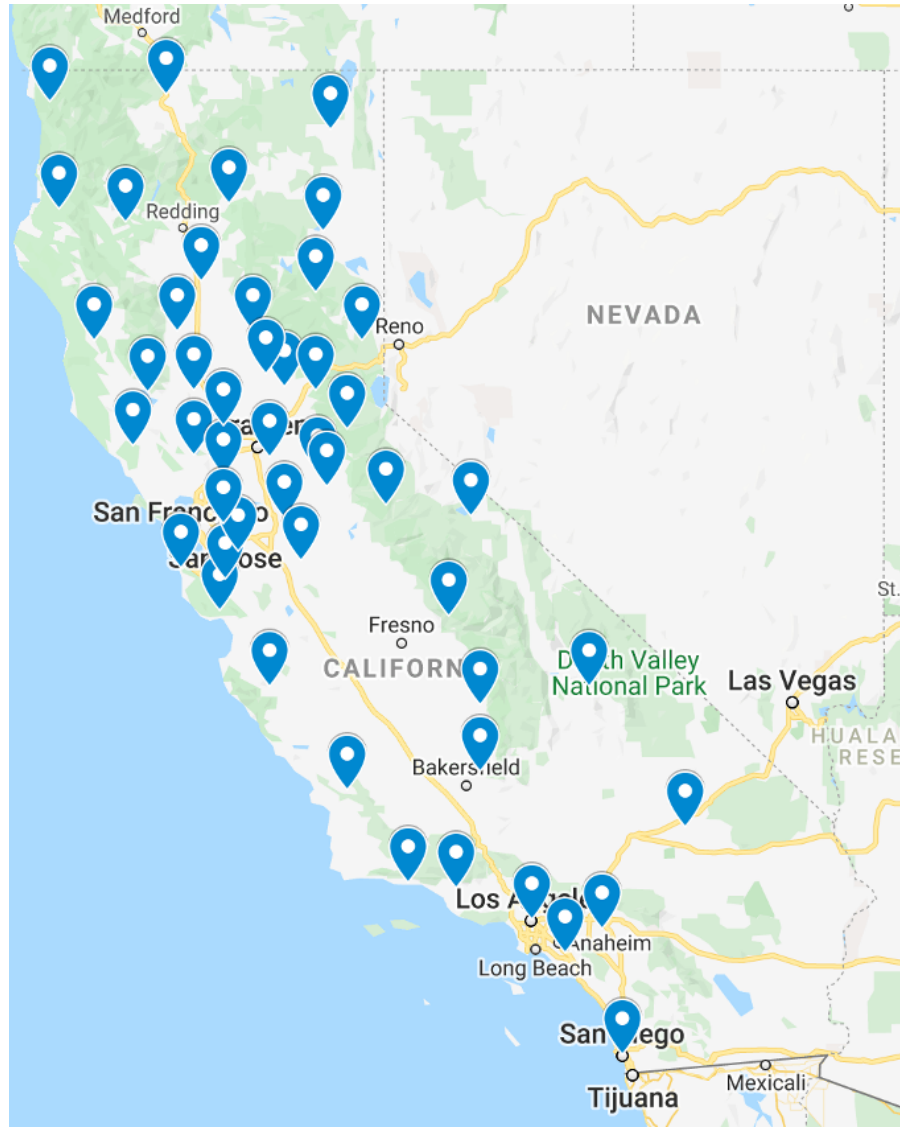
This funding has helped us make meaningful contributions to fire preparedness in our county. - Fire Safe Council of Santa Cruz County
